Brownsville, located at the southernmost tip of Texas and the US-Mexico border, is connected to Matamoros in Mexico by three bridges. The Rio Grande River separates the two locations, with the Brownsville & Matamoros International Bridge, Veterans International Bridge, and Gateway International Bridge providing crossing points. The Veterans Bridge offers more parking space and is a popular choice for those traveling with RVs or large vehicles. The bridges allow pedestrians to cross between countries, with the Gateway International Bridge being the easiest option for walking. The toll fees differ at each bridge: \$3.50 for passenger vehicles on the Veterans Bridge, \$3.25 for passenger vehicles on the Gateway Bridge, and \$3.00 for passenger vehicles on the Brownsville & Matamoros Bridge. Pedestrians pay a flat rate of \$1.00 at all bridges. The crossing hours vary slightly among the three bridges: the Brownsville & Matamoros Bridge and Gateway International Bridge are open 24/7, while the Veterans Bridge is open from 6 am to midnight daily. Duty-free stores, operated by Duty-Free Americas, are available at the Brownsville & Matamoros Bridge and Gateway International Bridge. To cross the border, a valid passport is required for all travelers. Members of Trusted Traveller programs like SENTRI or FAST may not need a passport as long as they have proof of membership and identification. ****Wait Times for International Bridges**** Two major international bridges in Brownsville have varying wait times throughout the day. Here is a breakdown of the current wait times for both bridges, categorized by time of day: ****Midnight to 6 AM****: During these early morning hours, wait times tend to be relatively short, ranging from less than 1 minute to around 10 minutes. ****7 AM to 9 PM****: As the day progresses, wait times gradually increase. The Brownsville & Matamoros International Bridge has an average wait time of around 20-30 minutes during this period, while the Brownsville Veterans International Bridge has slightly longer wait times, averaging around 30-40 minutes. ****10 PM to 11 PM****: In the late evening hours, wait times tend to decrease again, with averages ranging from less than 1 minute to around 15 minutes. Please note that these are general wait time estimates and may not reflect current conditions. The Brownsville-Matamoros International Bridge serves as one of the three key crossings on the U.S.-Mexico border between Brownsville, Texas, and Matamoros, Tamaulipas. This bridge is famously referred to as the old bridge due to its original construction still standing, making it the oldest international bridge in the area. Interestingly, this iconic bridge operates continuously for 24 hours a day.
